TASTING STATION HOSTS PROVIDE:

- Tasting-size samples of at least one signature dish, with enough samples for a crowd of 200 guests.
- Equipment necessary to prepare and/or heat their samples, display materials and decorations for their table.
- Disposable serveware for guest usage
- At least 1 (but ideally 2) staff to serve the food to guests.
- Partners raise awareness for Circle City Soiree by sharing the event and their participation

- Two (2) tables for food prep and service.
- Two (2) complimentary tickets to Circle City Soiree.
- At least one (1) social media post announcing partnership.
